Where can you find a job that offers good pay, flexible hours, paid training and the chance to work independently in your own community? The Highlands County Complete Count Campaign of the 2010 United States Census is seeking help with the census enumeration. Interviews and testing have already begun. The employment test consists of 28 multiple-choice questions designed to measure the skills and abilities required to perform a variety of census jobs, such as clerical, reading, number and organizational skills as well as interpreting information and evaluating alternatives. You may qualify if you are a U.S. citizen, a legal permanent resident or non-citizen with an appropriate work visa, are at least 18 years old, have a valid Social Security number, a valid driver's license and can pass a background check.
